Absolute Safety Management Inc. is currently hiring for a **Safety Supervisor / Rescue Technician**.

### **DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:**

The Safety Supervisor / Rescue Technician is responsible for these tasks, duties and areas:

- All Field Safety Operations, Training, administration and shop duties as required
- Safety and rescue equipment use, service, repair, maintenance and cleaning
- Safe vehicle operation, journey management, maintenance and cleaning
- Any and all assistance with corporate training and industrial rescue services as required

### **REQUIREMENTS:**

- Valid safety / rescue certifications (TBD) with the ability to maintain current at all times
- Knowledge of Alberta's Occupational Health & Safety Act, Code and Regulations
- Valid driver's license and clean driver's abstract (with the ability to maintain)
- 3 years' experience working in positions that would require confined space, high angle or rig work
- Advanced training in the field of safety or technical rescue is considered an asset (***may train***)
- Must be medically/physically fit and capable of hard work in demanding industrial rescue operations

The Safety Supervisor / Rescue Technician will be required to perform effectively and efficiently. The Safety Supervisor / Rescue Technician will also be required to maintain a clean driving record. Basic Industry and Rescue certification is required and must be maintained current at all times. Experience will dictate allowances to train for requirements.

### **INTERNAL RELATIONSHIPS:**

The Safety Supervisor / Rescue Technician will report to the General Manager or Administrator. He/she must develop and maintain good relationships with contactors and clients with regards to all safety and rescue operations.

### **CONDITIONS OF WORK:**

There will be an expectation for the Safety Supervisor / Rescue Technician to be available on call for field services and equipment preparation and cleaning 24 hours per day, at all times, within reason. Emergency travel throughout Western Canada for various job purposes may be required.

### **ATTRIBUTES:**

The Safety Supervisor / Rescue Technician must possess these qualities, aptitudes and temperament:

- Organized, prompt, efficient and effective during all situations
- Ability to make safe, sound, informed judgments and decisions
