- Assist with general integrity assessments across KMC operated pipelines
- Assist with facility and mainline integrity project management.
- Assist in reviewing pipeline risk results.
- Assist in reviewing historical pipe replacement data for input into the KMC Pipebook.
- Assist in loading integrity data into the risk database using 3rd party applications.
- Assist in creating risk result analysis and reports.
- Assist in dig database updates.
- Assist GIS group in formatting risk variables and data inputs.
- Occasionally (1-2 times throughout term) assist integrity engineers with field audits and investigations.

Position Requirements:

- Engineering student required; completion of 3rd year preferred.
- Knowledge or work experience in Pipeline or Oil/Gas industry considered an asset.
- Experience with regulatory environments (NEB, AER, OGC) or experience with CSA Z662 would be considered an asset.
