### GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

The Outreach Support Worker will circulate in the Prescription Drug Unit in the communities of the Standoff Town site, Moses Lake and Levern during peak times of drug use activity. This includes providing information, distributing harm reduction supplies and providing support to community members who may be struggling with addiction. The incumbent must be able to direct community members to appropriate services, and interact and communicate with the high and at-risk population in the community's (those who are actively misusing prescription drugs, abusing illicit drugs and other substances). This position will require the individual to work flexible hours primarily evening, nights and weekends, 3:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. and/or 4:00p.m.to 12:00 a.m. and Friday and Saturday evenings/nights.
