SUMMARY OF WORK:

Under the direction of the Deputy Fire Chief of the Blood Tribe Emergency Services, you are accountable to deliver fire suppression, prevention, and pre-hospital emergency care at the basic life support level in accordance with your professional designation as Primary Care Paramedic (PCP) NFPA 1001 (as defined by Alberta College of Paramedics and be an "Active Practitioner without Restrictions").

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- PCP will provide "on-site" medical care as required by the Blood Tribe Fire and Ambulance department, Occupational Health and Safety, and the Alberta College of Paramedics.
- Assess the extent of injuries and work within the PCP scope of practice as set by the health professions act and BTES protocols.
- Comfort and reassure patients
- Obtain the patients' medical history
- Perform and interpret diagnostic procedures such as taking vital signs and testing glucose levels.
- Administering a pre-hospital emergency care including cardiopulmonary resuscitation (cpr), oxygen, bandaging, splinting, assessing in child birth, and the treatment of trauma patients.
- Use a semi-automatic or automatic external defibrillator or bag valve mask resuscitator.
- Transport patients to hospital or other medical facilities for further care.

Professional Qualifications:

- Successfully completed training as a Primary Care Paramedic (PCP) from an approved program
- Registered with the Alberta College of Paramedics
- Valid CPR health care provider, and all qualifications that meet the requirements of the Health Professions Act and Regulations
- Must have a minimum of grade 12 diploma or equivalent
- Class 4 drivers licence with less than 6 demerits points or prohibition from driving under the criminal code. Knowledge of Blackfoot language and customs would be an asset.
